A BYLAW TO REQUIRE EVERY MUNICIPAL ELECTION CANDIDATE TO SUBMIT A CRIMINAL RECORD CHECK

BYLAW NO. 06/2011

The Council of the Northern Village of Green Lake in the Province of Saskatchewan, under the provision of Section 104 of *The Northern Municipalities Act*, 2010, enacts as follows:

- 1. It shall be lawful to require every person submitting their nomination for the position of Mayor or Alderman to provide a criminal record check in addition to the nomination paper submitted pursuant to section 46 of *The Local Government Elections Act*.
- 2. No nomination shall be deemed complete and accepted by the returning officer without the criminal record check.
- 3. Criminal record checks shall be in the form provided by the local RCMP detachment and shall display signature of commanding officer, date and seal.
- 4. Criminal record checks shall not be more than 3 months old at time of submission.
- 5. The returning officer or nomination officer shall post in a conspicuous place copies of the nominations received and accompanying documentation.
- 6. This bylaw shall come into force and take effect upon final reading by Council.
