GENERAL PENALTY BYLAW

BYLAW NO. 02/2011

The Council of the Northern Village of Green Lake in the Province of Saskatchewan under the provision of Subsection 402(1) of *The Northern Municipalities Act*, 2010 enacts as follows:

- 1. This bylaw shall be known and referred to as the "General Penalty Bylaw" of the Northern Village of Green Lake.
- 2. Section 3 shall apply only to an infraction of a bylaw of the Northern Village of Green Lake for which no other fine is specified in the bylaw or in another bylaw providing for a penalty with respect to contravention of that bylaw, or if no penalty is provided for by the bylaw:
- 3. Subject to the provisions of Section 2, any person who contravenes any provision of a bylaw of the northern municipality is guilty of an offense and liable on summary conviction to a fine of not more than:
 - a) \$2000.00 in the case of an Individual
 - b) \$5000.00 in the case of a Corporation
- 4. If a corporation commits an offence described in this section, any officer or director of the corporation who directed, authorized, assented to, acquiesced in or participated in the commission of the offence is guilty of the offence and liable on summary conviction to the penalties mentioned in this section in the case of individuals, whether or not the corporation has been prosecuted or convicted.
- 5. General Penalty Bylaw No. 03/86 passed on 13th day of March, 1986 is hereby repealed.
